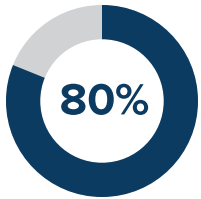


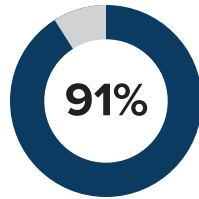


RFID on The Rise

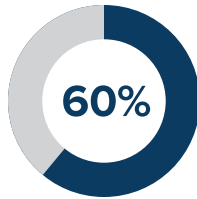

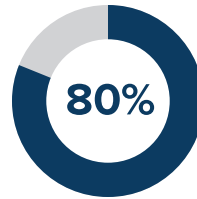
80% of warehouse leaders say they'll be using RFID for cycle counts and inventory validation by 2024.¹



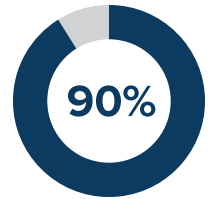
91% of manufacturers, 3PL providers, and retailers plan to invest in RFID inventory management systems by 2028.²



60% of warehouse leaders expect labor recruitment to be a challenge over the next five years.¹



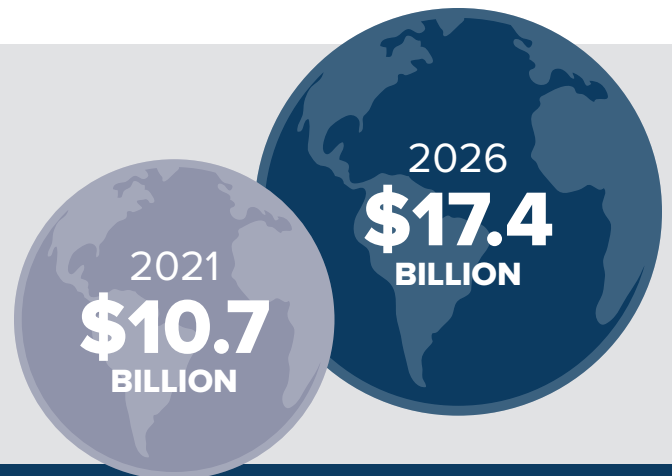
Using item level tagging delivers an 80% improvement in shipping/picking accuracy.³

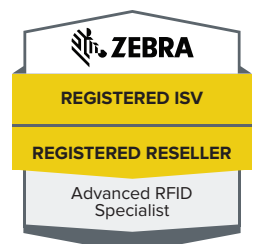
